... & the Jam Jar Prize

Still enjoying the company of other local artists at their Tuesday or Thursday Studio Sessions, the Stokes Artists mix in harmony like the colours on their paint palette, and always look forward to meeting and greeting new members into the fold.

Founded in November 2011 the SAG is still self supporting and looking toward its 5th year as a Community art group serving the Stokes of South Gloucestershire, and neighbouring areas.

The Jam Jar Prize, the SAG Annual Award, is still drawing interest from its members, though entries are down on previous years. However, the standard remains high and well worth viewing.

JJP entries can be of any subject and size, can be the original painting or a suitable Print; can be presented as unmounted, mounted, framed or unframed. Copyright of all entries should be that of the Artist, or have proven permission to use an image or idea first created by another—details provided by the Artist are given where relevant and should be taken into account when judging.

The Award is recognised as prestigious rather than valuable, keeping the original idea of a simple Jam Jar as the coveted prize; however, a token £10 Hobby-craft Voucher and Winner's Certificate is included. There is also a 'Highly Commended' Certificate for 2nd Place, a 3rd Place Certificate, and seven 'Best Of Category' Certificates to be won: but apart from all that the JJP is fast becoming our Annual Exhibition to showcase collective talents. In other words, individually there is a good reason for every member to enter no matter what their level of ability- it's the fun of taking part that counts!

The JJP Judging Process

... **NEW FOR 2015**

To ring the changes, and balance out the overall selection of the winning entries, a new judging process is being trialled this year.

FIRST ROUND—BEST OF CATEGORY WINNERS

Each Category Winner will be selected by judges appointed from non-participating members, past members and associates.

Category Judges will be announced in the week before the event.

FINAL JUDGING—1ST PLACE, 2ND PLACE & 3RD PLACED ENTRIES

All Category winning artworks will be red-starred and brought to the front table ready for final judging.

Mike & Rosemary Day will then select the Winner of the 2015 Jam Jar Prize, Runner Up, and—new for this year— a 3rd Place selection.
















