... the Jam Jar Prize ... Marchesi Awards—& Series 3 Project

What is the Jam Jar Prize?

The Jam Jar Prize is our mini version of London's Turner Prize, and an established annual event at the Stokes Art Group. The free event, open to all current members, was derived from the very first Project staged over the winter of 2012 when in the absence of any funds to award a fantastic Prize, an empty Jam Jar was given to the Winner—as better than nothing at all... well, surely every Artist needs one! Since then a token gift of a £10 & £5 Hobbycraft Gift Voucher is added for the Winner & 2nd Place respectively—however, the Jam Jar is still highly coveted. There are no restrictions: Entries can be of any subject, size, Original or suitable commercial Print, and with no set presentation format. The only stipulation is that whilst copyright automatically falls to the artist for the artwork itself—the FULL COPYRIGHT of all entries must be owned by the submitting Artist—either solely created from their own original idea or photograph; from a copyright-free image with full details supplied; copied from an Instructional Exercise and signed 'AFTER A.N.Other'; or with written permissions to use an image or idea created by A.N.Other.

The JJP Judging Process

... & the 2019 Judges

JUDGING PROCESS

FIRST ROUND JUDGING: All Entries are displayed and judged within 7 categories.

The only criteria that must be met is correct Copyright (see p3); judging should not be based on Artistic ability alone, but include an overall quality which is pleasing to the eye. <u>BEST OF CATEGORY WINNERS</u>—the Category Judges select one artwork from each category. In the event of a Tie between two entries —the Head Judge is invited to give the Casting Vote.

<u>HIGHLY COMMENDED</u>—from the remaining display the judges can select one entry that although did not beat the best in its category, should be recognised.

FINAL SELECTION

<u>TOP 3 ARTWORKS</u>—from the shortlisted 7 Best of Category winning entries, the Guest Head Judge selects his/her Top 3 entries to take the 2019 Jam Jar Prize Awards.

JUDGES

CATEGORY JUDGES— Janet Rugman & Alison Georgiou, as non participating members they have kindly accepted the challenge to judge the JJP Categories this year. JANET joined the SAG in Series 1 as a fairly new self learning artist, but although working for an ophthalmic optics company—understanding the need for clarity all too well—she is not yet clear where her artistic niche will be so is trying her hand at all mediums & genres enthusiastically, including painting on glass! // ALISON, a former Nurse - now in Education, is our newest member having only joined in October. Before moving back to the UK last year, Alison attended art classes and painted with a similar art group in Cyprus. Her preferred medium is Acrylic on large canvas, and enjoys replicating the old Masters.





GUEST HEAD JUDGE—Tanya Chandler, Roger Smith's daughter, had no hesitation in



accepting the invitation to judge the SAG Series 3 Project 'After R Smith' based on his artwork. Possible unaware at that time the role also included being JJP Head Judge—she will be busy on the night. Tanya does not come from an artistic background, but as she explains 'For the last 30 odd years I have been trying to figure out what I really want to do when I grow up - and now at the tender age of 43,

I am embarking on an Open University Degree in English Literature and Creative Writing. For the past 20 years I have worked in University Administration.' As for creative Art, she added 'I am a great admirer of anyone who can produce artwork in all its forms. I have dabbled with crafting, mainly card making, over the years but have never tried my hand at painting - I left that to my Dad.'

ENTRY IDENTIFICATION CODE: All Entries have an ID Code such as 7-AC01

7= the Category number **-AC**= Artists initials **01**= entry number (01-05). IDs can be cross referenced to the contributing artists listed on page 6.

GALLERY: All images within this catalogue should be viewed as representative, therefore colours and clarity may differ slightly from the original work.

DETAILS SUPPLIED BY THE ARTIST:

- Medium/Media— As given
- Support—Paper is used as the Support unless otherwise specified.
- Original or Print— The Original artwork is entered unless stated as a PRINT.
- Size is given in imperial and metric—Images are not to scale against each other.

 - ⇒ COPYRIGHT 'AFTER'—Where the term <u>©After A.N.Other</u> in black is used, Copyright for the artwork <u>only</u> is owned by the artist when copied exactly or very close to an original artwork or photograph—ie from instructional exercise not requiring direct permissions for its use but <u>due credits back have been supplied</u>.


